The ISEE

Bespoke's ISEE course will improve students' confidence and test-taking skills by giving them an in-depth knowledge of the ISEE exam so that they can walk in on Test Day knowing exactly what to do. Classes will cover the content and strategies for all sections of the ISEE and will include both Bespoke's materials and real, released questions. Each course includes ISEE sections taken under timed conditions so that students can practice in a test-like, proctored environment.

Students receive a 300+ page lesson book filled with Bespoke's practice questions, homework, drills, and strategies.

NOTE: *This course is for students in 7th through 9th grade ONLY. 7th graders take the Middle Level ISEE exam, but can benefit greatly from this course, which will push them with more advanced math and vocabulary.*

Information about the ISEE

The Independent School Entrance Examination (ISEE) is produced by the ERB (Educational Records Bureau). It is used for admission to private middle schools, junior high schools, and high schools. The test consists of four multiple-choice sections; verbal reasoning (synonyms and sentence completions), quantitative reasoning, reading comprehension, and math achievement. The test also contains an essay section in which students are given 30 minutes to write on an assigned topic; the essay is not graded but a copy of it will be sent to each school that receives an ISEE score report. The entire test takes approximately two and a half hours to administer. There are three versions of the ISEE:

- Lower Level-for students in the 4th and 5th grades applying to the 5th and 6th grades
- Middle Level-for students in 6th and 7th grades applying to the 7th and 8th grades
- *Upper Level-for students in 8th grade and above applying to the 9th grade and above*

The ISEE is administered on various dates from November through March. It can be taken at several locations throughout New York City and elsewhere.
