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FAQ: Answers to questions you are probably asking...

How is Bespoke's private education program accredited? We partner with online school Laurel Springs, based in California, as a foundation for our program, because it is a fully accredited online school. Bespoke has been home-schooling students for many years using the accredited Laurel Springs program, so we know it well. Bespoke's instructors will cover all required Laurel Springs course content in person each day and will supplement this content as needed to maintain course coverage at a level commensurate with that of top NYC private schools. Each week, students will complete Laurel Springs assessments and assignments corresponding to the content covered in class, which will be graded by Laurel Springs' faculty. Bespoke's students also will have access to Laurel Springs faculty and curricular materials as supplements to what we cover each day. *

Why take this program with Bespoke? Bespoke has been tutoring and teaching students in New York for nearly twenty years; we know the curricula at most schools very well, and we will make sure that students have an engaging and challenging academic program. Many of Bespoke's teachers have Masters or Doctoral degrees in their fields, and all go through a rigorous, extensive training program with us. And, we have used the Laurel Springs program over the years to teach all subjects at every level, up through Advanced Placement classes.

What subjects will be taught? Grade-level science, math, history, and English are required "core subjects." When the student groups are set for each grade level, we will customize 1 to 2 other classes of interest, such as a foreign language, a new content area, or independent study. In addition, Laurel Springs requires a health class for certain grades as well as PhysEd., both of which can be followed online and supported where necessary by our teachers.

How will each day be structured? Just the same as most regular school days, with classes that are approximately 50 minutes long with a 10-minute break between classes for older students, and more frequent breaks and activities for younger students. Start and end times will be staggered so that only one class of 4-6 students is transiting through the common office space at a time. Each day will have six academic classes. Classes will generally start around 830am and end around 330pm depending on grade level. Students will eat lunch in their own pods. Our intent is to mitigate health risks by keeping each small student group separated from the other groups as much as possible.

** In place of Laurel Springs' program: if your child's school is planning to use "off" or "Zoom" days for assignments students have to complete on their own or asynchronous video learning, consider having Bespoke's expert tutors support your child's learning live and in-person: students won't have to learn solely from a computer screen; they can work 1-on-1 or with a small group of friends; they'll cover all the necessary course content for school and even go further in the material; and they also have the option of getting out of the house to learn in-person with their friends at our office. Program pricing is based on the customized program.*



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Will students be separated by grade? Yes. One opportunity here is to have groups of friends from the same grade enroll together, and you may be able to help us organize this for your children. We can also combine groups of two grade levels if you want.

Will students get credit for the semester or year at Bespoke when they apply to college? Students will receive transcripts from Laurel Springs when they complete the required coursework: <https://laurelsprings.com/about-our-school/accreditation/>.

Will students get credit for the semester or year at Bespoke from their current schools? Our experience to date has been that all schools accept coursework completed in Laurel Springs' program. Bespoke will also supply a letter to your current school, if needed, detailing the course of study. You will, however, want to check with your current school.

How will you maintain social distancing and COVID-19 safety? Each of Bespoke's offices has multiple individual classrooms well-suited for 4 to 6 students. Each group will have its own dedicated classroom, so kids are using the same space each day. We will clean and disinfect all rooms at the end of each day, and more frequently if needed; we will stagger start and lunch times and mandate mask usage for transit through common spaces; we will also supply face shields to students to use in lieu of masks in the classroom if they prefer; and we will urge teachers and students to monitor their own health from home and to stay home if unwell. While we cannot guarantee anyone's health, we believe these protocols will strike the right balance between creating a good experience for your child and not taking unnecessary exposure risk. In addition, we can switch quickly to online sessions if health or other reasons require it.

Tuition and registration are very flexible...

Fall semester: \$18,500 (includes all Laurel Springs registration costs) *

- September 8th through December 19th, standard vacations

Spring semester: \$19,500 (includes all Laurel Springs registration costs) *

- January 5th through June 12th, standard vacations

For Fall 2020, full tuition is due by August 1st - by credit card, check, or cash. *

For Spring 2021, full tuition is due by December 1st. *

Register siblings and take 10% off each tuition.

* Fall tuition is 50% refundable up until August 15th, 2020, and Spring tuition is 50% refundable up until December 15th, 2020. The non-refunded portion may be retained as a credit toward Bespoke tutoring and mock testing services through 12/31/21.
