## **Description**

The Common App essay: one of the most important parts of the college admissions process is also the toughest to get right. The hard data included in the rest of your application—your grades, your extracurriculars, your test scores—can only tell admissions committees so much about who you are as a person. On paper, college applicants can be difficult to tell apart. The essay plays a critical role in helping you stand out from the enormous crowd of candidates they must confront each year.

The trouble is that most high school students have limited experience writing in the first person. Many teachers even expressly forbid it. You know yourself better than anyone else, but when it comes time to translate that crucial self-knowledge into six hundred and fifty words of prose, you might find yourself at a loss. It is such a huge, daunting task that simply choosing a single topic can seem impossible.

This workshop will help you navigate this challenge. We will begin by talking about what makes for a good college essay; we will look at examples of essays that earned admission to top US universities; and we will pull them apart piece-by-piece to figure out what makes them tick. Then, once we have a firm grasp on what makes a strong essay, we will get personal: what is it about you that an admissions committee must know?

Through a series of exercises and workshop discussions, you will brainstorm about a list of possible essay subjects and make rough outlines for each. Together, we will explore how your essay might be structured; how it might incorporate essential information; and how it might begin and end. By the end of the workshop, you will have a much clearer idea of where your essay might take you, and you will be ready for the next step: facing the blank page.

Later in the summer, you will meet with your instructor one-on-one, either to discuss a first pass you have completed or to create a more detailed outline of the draft you will write in the fall. In either case, by the start of the school year, you will be well on your way to a final draft.
