We are currently working in partnership with more than twenty public schools, charter schools and nonprofit organizations that serve low-income students. In SY 2022-2023, we will serve more than 3500 students in grades 3 through 12.

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Services

- **Test Preparation** - We offer the most rigorous preparation for all standardized tests, including SAT, ACT, AP, NYS Regents, ISEE, SSAT, and SHSAT. Our school partnerships for test preparation include strategy and content lessons, timed practice tests, and parent information seminars.
- **Academic Support** - We help students excel in their academic courses through writing and math centers, 1:1 tutoring, and small-group classes ranging from remediation through gifted-and-talented learning.
- **College Readiness** - We offer support for your college office through our talented college advisors, as well as essay writing and application workshops.
- **Leadership Development** - We offer professional development and teacher training programs, create and support experiential learning and service learning programs, and offer high-level courses in entrepreneurship, financial literacy, and more.

Results

- At a leading independent school in NYC, we ran a year-long SAT test preparation class. Students averaged a 115 point increase in their SAT scores (out of a 1600 scale).
- At another prominent independent school in NYC, we ran a semester-long ACT preparation class. Students averaged a 4.25 point increase in their ACT scores (out of a 36 scale)
- At a leading charter school network in NYC, we ran a 10 week ELA program for 3rd to 8th graders, who were failing or struggling. After Bespoke's class, 68% of the students passed the final assessment. 90% reported that their confidence had significantly improved in reading and writing.
- At another prominent charter school network in NYC, we ran a year-long math enrichment program. A majority of 5th-graders passed their final assessment.
- At the same charter network, we ran a 7-week AP test preparation class for high school students. In our AP World History class, students averaged 84% attendance throughout the class.
