# DIGITAL





- International students will begin taking the digital SAT in March of 2023.
- PSAT students will take a digital version of that test in the fall of 2023.
- Students in the United States will have their first opportunity to take the digital SAT in March of 2024.
- For students looking to take the SAT during the spring of their junior year, the class of 2025 will be the first class to exclusively take the new digital SAT.

### **FORMAT:**

- Digital via College Board Blue Book app
- Administered in proctored setting with students using their own/provided devices

### LENGTH:

• 2 hours and 14 minutes

## **STRUCTURE:**

 The questions in second stage of each section will depend on a student's performance in the first stage

### **SECTIONS:**

- Two sections, each with two modules
- Reading & writing module one and two (each 32 minutes and 27 items)
- Math module one and two (each 35 minutes and 22 items)

# **ACCOMMODATIONS:**

• Current accommodation policy maintained

 Paper and pencil "bubble" test administered in proctored setting

• 3 hours

• The test will not change based on student performance

- Two sections, each with two parts
- Reading & writing Reading (65 minutes and 52 items) Writing (35 minutes and 44 items)
- Math
   No calculator (25 minutes and 20 items
   Calculator (55 minutes and 38 items)

# **EXTRA QUESTIONS:**

 Both reading & writing and math will have four unscored questions spread throughout the test

# **SCORING SCALE:**

- 400-1600 total score
- 200-800 scores for both reading & writing and math

## **SUPERSCORES**:

· Likely allowed

# **SCORING REPORTS:**

- Reports available days after the test
- Students will not have access to their questions and answers

- Partial use (see math sections above)
- Students often receive a fifth section of unscored questions
- 400-1600 total score
- 200-800 scores for both reading & writing and math
- Allowed
- Reports available 2-3 weeks after test
- Question-and-answer service available by request
